

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The City of Trenton has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 1.31 percent. All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at City Hall, 12882 North Main Street on September 3, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. and again at 6:00 p.m.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at City Hall, 12882 North Main Street, on September 14, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in keeping the current millage rate of 4.498, an increase of 0.058 over the “rollback” millage rate of 4.440. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 4.440 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$2.32 per year and the proposed tax increase for a nonhomestead property with a fair market value of \$50,000 is approximately \$1.45.
