5. IGA for Economic Development Director – The City would like to have a monthly report either presented by the Director or sent via email for the Commission Meetings.

Prohibited Discharges addition to code section 46-83(11) – add section (d) to read any prohibited discharges, where the waste is exceeding our current restrictions based on the City sewer EPD permits, can be approved by the wastewater superintendent and the City Commission on a case-by-case study.
7. Town Creek Trail – Resolution R-36-20 from Dade County Commission was reviewed. An easement from Dade County and Citizens Bank & Trust, Inc. were given to and accepted by the City of Trenton as an easement for the right to build and maintain a pedestrian and bicycle trail on the property owned by each entity. The trail will be determined by the City of Trenton and Scenic Dade Development Company. A grant has been secured by Scenic Dade Development, Ms. Jennifer Blair was present to give an explanation of those grants. One of which was awarded for \$75,000.00, the City of Trenton agreed to match 10% of this grant or \$7500.00 to be paid from the Hotel/Motel Fund.
