- 1. Call to Order: Mayor Joseph Case at 10:32 am**

- 2. First Public Hearing for Adoption 2023 Budget and 2022 Millage Rate**

Present for this 1st hearing was Commissioner Wooten and Mayor Case. There were 2 citizens from the county present at this public hearing.

Mayor Case stated this meeting was the 1st of 3 public hearings to discuss the City's 2023 Proposed Budget and 2022 Millage Rate. The proposed budget is set at \$2,198,124.60 for 2023 and we are looking to accept the growth and keep the current millage rate at 4.498 mils. Because there is an increase we must have 3 public hearings. The citizens present understood why this was being done. Mayor Case went over the different types of taxes and services that affect the way we have to run the city. (There were documents present for the citizens to see and follow along with). This budget has no capital improvement. All capital improvement comes from Local Option Sales Tax which is paid by everyone coming in and purchasing things. There was discussion back and forth on how the city runs and what taxes apply to what and how. The citizens present stated they live in the county but frequent the city a lot for purchases and would just like to know how things are run here. At the end of the meeting the citizens understood why the city is taking the growth to maintain the functions of the city.
