
1. **Call to Order: Mayor Joseph Case at 6:00 P.M.**

2. **Third and Final Public Hearing for Adoption 2023 Budget and 2022 Millage Rate**

Present for this 3rd hearing was Commissioner Powell, Commissioner Houts, Commissioner Wooten and Mayor Case. There were two citizens present at this public hearing.

Mayor Case stated this was the 3rd and final public hearing to discuss the City's 2023 Proposed Budget and 2022 Millage Rate. The proposed budget is set at \$2,198,124.60 for 2023 and we are looking to accept the growth and keep the current millage rate at 4.498 mils. There were a couple of questions but not city related. Mayor Case went over the different taxes and services that effect the operations of the city. (Documents were provided) Mayor Case mentioned how the taxes are split when purchasing in the city limits from county residents. The two county residents understood the millage rate and budget.
