A printed copy of the October 2020 Treasurer's report was provided and reviewed by Treasurer Dianne Monson.

A motion by James Lingel to approve the 2020 budget for \$312136.27. Kurt Monson seconded; motion carried.

Discussion of the invoices/bills to be paid was completed by the Board Members. A motion to approve payment of the bills was made by Kurt Monson; second by James Lingel; motion carried.

Kurt Monson made a motion to send the left-over funds from our Routes to Recovery grant to Richland County, seconded by James Lingel; motion to carried.

Clerks Report: General Election was November 3, 2020. Town of Dayton has 451 registered voters with 393 voting in this historic election.
