

Board Meeting / Town of Dayton Wednesday January 12, 2022

Town Board Meeting was called to order by Chairman Clark at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. It was determined that the agenda was posted at the proper locations.

The meeting agenda was read by Chairman Clark. A motion to approve the agenda was made by James Lingel; second by Kurt Monson; motion carried.

A printed copy of the November 2021 and December 2021 Treasurer's reports was provided for Board Members to review by Dianne Monson Treasurer.

Clerk Ewing provided written copies and read the minutes of the December Board meeting. Motion by James Lingel to approve the minutes; second by Kurt Monson; motioned carried.

RCFD meeting was attended by Kurt Monson, Kim Clark, and James Lingel. Judy Shadwell is going to send the bill by email and paper copy. Once the bill is received it will be due in 30 days.

Richland County passed an ordinance that prohibits livestock running at large. The term "running at large" in this ordinance means any cattle, horses, sheep, goats, llamas, alpacas, pigs, poultry, or any other domesticated animal that is off premises and is not under supervision of the owner or responsible party. Any person who has 5 or more complaints per calendar year will be fined.

Fines are as follows: First offense will range between \$25.00 to \$169; second offense will range between \$50.00 to \$232.00; third offense will range between \$100.00 -389.50. The ordinance took effect immediately. For more information on this ordinance visit the Richland County ordinances.

Boaz Cemetery member Sandy Campbell would like to transfer over the Boaz Cemetery to Dayton Township. Kim Clark will investigate what the protocol for taking over the Boaz Cemetery will be for Dayton Township.

Discussion of the invoices/bills to be paid was completed by the Board. A motion to approve payment of the bills was made by Kurt Monson; second by James Lingel; motion carried.

Clerk Report: There will be no February Election for the Town of Dayton. W2's will be out by the end of the month.

Patrolman Report: Had to replace the air bags in the Peterbilt. Kerry needs to do Mine Training. He will look to see if he can get it.

There was not any public input.

There were not any driveway permits.

There were not any zoning requests.

James Lingel made a motion to approve an operator's license for Kyla Burkum for Mel's Micro Brew; seconded by Kurt Monson; motion approved.

Chairman Clark reported on the February Calendar of events and reviewed the WTA February newsletter.
