

The Town of Dayton Budget Hearing and Special Town Meeting were called to order by Chairman Clark at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

A motion to adopt the 2023 tax levy of \$154,068.00 was made by James Lingel; second by Kurt Monson; motion carried.

A motion to adjourn the Special Town meeting was made by Kurt Monson; second by Jim Lingel; motion carried.

Clerk Ewing read the minutes of the October Board meeting. Kurt Monson approved the minutes; seconded by James Lingel; motion carried.

A printed copy of the October 2022 Treasurer's report was provided and reviewed by Treasurer Dianne Monson.

Discussion of the invoices/bills to be paid was completed by the Board Members. A motion to approve payment of the bills was made by Kurt Monson; second by James Lingel; motion carried.

Dan Shannon and Joni Sharp addressed the board on a fence issue with a neighbor. The board is going to send a letter to the landowner reminding him of the fence laws.

The clerk position was decided by the voters for the Town of Dayton to appoint a clerk vs elect a clerk for 2023. The position will be salaried. Interviews will be scheduled the week of Nov. 29- 12/2, With a tentative start date of January 1, 2023. Clerk will stay on her term to assist the new appointed clerk.
