August 1, 2024 at 6:00 p.m.**




1. **Luna called the meeting to order.**
2. **Luna led the Pledge of Allegiance.**
3. **Arthur said the Invocation**
4. **Approval of the Financials:** Kerber made a motion to approve the financials as presented. Johnson seconded the motion. Luna asked if there was any discussion, and there was none. Luna called for a vote, and all voted in favor of the motion.
5. **Approval of the Minutes:** Johnson made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Arthur seconded the motion. Luna asked if there was any discussion, and there was none. Luna called for a vote, and all voted in favor of the motion.
6. **Citizens Comments:** none
7. **Ordinance 24-234 – Amend Personnel Policy – Second Reading:** Brandon stated this ordinance was created to change the Short - Term Disability clause in the Personnel Policy of Ordinance 23-295. Kerber made a motion to adopt Ordinance 24-234 in second reading as presented. McClintock seconded the motion. Luna asked if there was any discussion, and there was none. Luna called for a vote, and all voted in favor of the motion.
8. **Other Business:**
 - a. Events Committee Account set up – Brandon asked if the Board wants to keep the Events Committee funds in the General Fund or do they want to have the funds transferred into the Events Committee Fund into which all the electronic funds from fundraisers will go. He stated he wants to eliminate possible exposure in the General Fund with Venmo and other digital transactions. Kerber made a motion to keep the Events Committee funds separate and transfer Events Committee funds from the General Fund to the Events Committee Fund. Johnson seconded the motion.

- b. Brandon stated the property at 521 South Main Street has sold, money received, and deed transferred to the new owner. He asked the board if they wanted him to pay the debt down or keep in General Fund. Arthur made a motion for Brandon to pay the debt down if needed. McClintock seconded the motion. Luna asked if there was any discussion, and there was none. Luna called for a vote, and all voted in favor of the motion.
- c. Brandon stated due to time constraints, he was not able to get the new Fireworks Ordinance written but will make sure it is on the September Agenda.

Johnson made a motion to adjourn. Kerber seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.
