

## **ORDINANCE 24-334**

## AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING ALTERNATE VENUES FOR THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN REGULAR MONTHLY OR SPECIAL MEETINGS AND THE MEETINGS OF TOWN BOARDS

WHEREAS, the Charter for the Town of Cornersville, TN, Chapter No. 150, House Bill No.2880, SECTION 14 provides, "The Board of Mayor and Aldermen shall hold at least one (1) regular meeting each month for the transaction of business. The place and time of the regular meeting shall be at the Town Hall on the first Thursday of each month unless changed by ordinance.." and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cornersville occasionally does not have sufficient seating for citizens at the Cornersville Town Hall to transact business at a regular monthly, special, or other board meeting;

## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Regular monthly, special, or other board meetings shall be held at the Cornersville Town Hall unless the below section applies.

**SECTION 2.** If adequate notice indicating an alternate venue is provided by representatives of the Town of Cornersville, the venue can be changed as noticed.

**SECTION 3.** If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason declared invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance that is not itself invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately after its final passage, the public welfare demanding it.
