### A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE, TENNESSEE DECLARING A GOLF CART TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND SOLD.

**WHEREAS**, municipal property must be declared surplus before it is disposed of or sold; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:**


**SECTION 1.** The Town of Cornersville has determined a golf cart, further identified as a 2002 Clubcar with serial number AG0233-184617, is surplus to the needs of the Town; and,


**SECTION 2.** The Town Administrator is authorized to advertise and sell the abovenamed golf cart. The preferred method of sale shall be a public auction, on a cash, certified check, or if applicable, debit or credit card basis. A public auction may include the use of a nationally recognized government surplus website, such as GovDeals.com

**SECTION 3.** If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution is for any reason declared invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution that is not itself invalid or unconstitutional.


**SECTION 4.** All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
