

ORDINANCE 22-282

AN ORDINANCE MAKING SOUTH PARK STREET ONE WAY, AND APPROVING REQUEST FOR ENGINEERING PROPOSALS TO REMOVE THE EXISTING SIDEWALK, REPLACE THE SIDWALK, AND LAYOUT PARKING SPACES

WHEREAS, the Town of Cornersville desires to eliminate two-way traffic on South Park Street to improve traffic flow and increase parking along the street;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. South Park Street shall be one-way from Mulberry Street to Highway 31A.

SECTION 2. Traffic spaces shall accommodate traffic traveling west to east.

SECTION 3. All ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason declared invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance that is not itself invalid or unconstitutional.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage the public welfare requiring it.
