



RESOLUTION 26-367

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE ROUNDING CASH TRANSACTIONS TO THE NEAREST NICKEL TO COMPENSATE FOR THE DISCONTINUANCE OF PENNIES

WHEREAS, The U.S. Mints discontinued minting pennies; and

WHEREAS, There is a shortage of pennies in circulation; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND
ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:**


SECTION 1. If exact change is not possible, the Town of Cornersville will round to the nearest nickel for cash payments.

SECTION 2. All electronic payments, which include Automated Clearing Housing (ACH), credit cards, debit cards, or other electronic payments, and checks will not be rounded.


SECTION 3. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution is for any reason declared invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution that is not itself invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. Any Resolution in conflict herewith is repealed in its entirety.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage this 5th day of March, 2026, the public welfare requiring it.
