



RESOLUTION 26-368

A RESOLUTION BY THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ADVANCE PAVING TO PAVE THE TOWN HALL PARKING LOT AND PORTIONS OF BEECHWOOD AVE

WHEREAS, The Town of Cornersville adopted, with Ordinance 07-96, the Municipal Purchasing Law of 1983 codified as TCA §6-56-301 et seq as the official purchasing procedures for the town; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance 07-96 requires purchases of all goods and services exceeding an amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to be publicly advertised and competitively bid; and,

WHEREAS, This project will exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00); and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Cornersville publicly advertised for sealed bids in the Marshall County Post, a newspaper of general circulation, on February 12, 2026, and the Town's website on February 4, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, The Town Administrator received four bids before the deadline expired; and,

WHEREAS, Advance Paving met the project specifications and was the apparent low bidder on February 26, 2026, at 3:00 PM at the bid-opening; and,


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Taylor Brandon, Town Administrator, and Billy Ostermann, Town Attorney, are authorized to negotiate and execute a contract for, and on behalf of, the Town of Cornersville for paving the Town Hall parking lot, portions of Beechwood Ave, and other areas permitted by cost.


SECTION 2. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution is for any reason declared invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution that is not itself invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. The contract shall be made within the limits of the approved budget and the appropriations for which the purchase is made consistent with TCA §6-56-303.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage this 5th day of March, 2026, the public welfare requiring it.


