ORDINANCE NO. 08-118

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE, TENNESSEE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 08-111 REGARDING DOGS WITHIN THE TOWN

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Cornersville, Tennessee, desires to amend Ordinance No. 08-111 to regulate the ownership or keeping of dogs on residential property within the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 08-111 of the Town of Cornersville is amended by deleting the following language of the subsection "Number of dogs on premises restricted": "of less than $\frac{1}{2}$ acre; the keeping or maintaining more than (6) dogs over six (6) months old on any property larger than ¹/₂ acre but less than 1 acre is prohibited."

The amended provision shall read as follows:

Number of dogs on premises restricted. In a district designated as residential on the official zoning map of the town, keeping or maintaining more than four (4) dogs over six (6) months old on the premises is prohibited.

Any persons owning more than four (4) dogs upon the effective date of this Ordinance shall have thirty (30) days after such effective date to voluntarily comply with this amendment. All other provisions of Ordinance No, 08-111 shall not be affected by this amendment.

SECTION 2. If any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion, of this Resolution which is not itself invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
