



RESOLUTION 24-323

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE, TENNESSEE DECLARING LUMBER AND SHEET METAL FROM THE WATER STREET PAVILION TO BE SURPLUS TO THE TOWN'S NEEDS AND DIRECTING DISPOSAL OF SAME.

WHEREAS, the Town of Cornersville owns a pavilion at Caboose Park on Water Street that was damaged by high winds May 22, 2024;


WHEREAS, the Town of Cornersville has determined that the lumber and sheet metal from the pavilion are surplus to the needs of the Town; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. That the Public Works Department is authorized to dispose and/or sell, for a reasonable price, the sheet metal and lumber from the pavilion.

SECTION 2. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution is for any reason declared invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution that is not itself invalid or unconstitutional.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage this 11th day of July, 2024, the public welfare requiring it.


