



RESOLUTION 24-326

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BULLDAWG TRAILS AND A PORTION OF DUBOSE LANE AS PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article 5, Section I, page 5-4 of the Town of Cornersville Municipal Subdivision Regulations effective October 30, 2023, dedication of roads, streets, and rights-of-way shall be accepted by formal action of the Cornersville Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

WHEREAS, Cameron Coble constructed Bulldawg Trails and 950 linear feet of Dubose Lane for a subdivision.

WHEREAS, Cameron Coble is requesting that the Town of Cornersville accept Bulldawg Trails and the completed portion of Dubose Lane.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CORNERSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The roads have been completed.


SECTION 2. The Town of Cornersville has inspected the roads and determined that the roads meet current regulations.

SECTION 3. The Town of Cornersville formally approves, accepts, and takes full title to Bulldawg Trails and 950 linear feet of Dubose Lane as a public right-of-way.


SECTION 4. The Town of Cornersville will provide maintenance thereafter to the accepted roads.

SECTION 5. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution is for any reason declared invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Resolution that is not itself invalid or unconstitutional.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage this 11th day of July, 2024, the public welfare requiring it.


