The body convened in open session as the Municipal Board of Canvassers (MBOC) and the Local Board of Canvassers (LBOC) at 8:00 p.m.

Due to the extended deadline for the receipt of absentee ballots for this election, we have been instructed by the Wisconsin Elections Commission to count the ballots but NOT tally the votes until after 4:00 p.m. on April 13, 2020.

At 8:00 p.m. it was verified that the display on the voting machine indicated 26 ballots cast. No seals were broken on the machine. The voting machine was turned off, unplugged, wheeled back to the Clerk's office, and plugged back in.

The two poll lists were compared and the certification pages (EL-107) were completed.

The ballot boxes were opened, and the ballots were counted but not tallied. There were 7 Official ballots for each of the following: Presidential Preference Vote, Nonpartisan Office (State and County), Referendum, School Board, and Nonpartisan Office (Boaz Village Trustee).

Voted paper ballots were placed in a plastic ballot bag with a tamper-evident seal and sealed shut. The bag was signed and dated.

The number of ballots cast (33) were compared to the number of voters (33).

There were no provisional ballots cast.

There were 7 absentee ballots issued. Note: all 7 absentee ballots were returned and counted prior to the closing of the polls.

Everything that could be completed on the Inspectors' Statement (EL-104) was filled in.

All materials were handed over to the Clerk to be securely stored in the Clerk's office until the MBOC and LBOC reconvenes at 4:00 p.m. on April 13, 2020.

The American flag and sign for persons needing assistance were brought in from outside.

The Election Inspectors completed their time sheets for the day.

The meeting of the MBOC and LBOC ended at 8:30 p.m.
