President Nicks called the public hearing to order at 4:18 p.m.

One change was made to the expenses for the General Fund since the October regular meeting of the Boaz Village Board. Clerk/Treasurer Hauri received an invoice 11-2-21 for \$3,000 for Year 1 of 2 for the Comprehensive Plan. As a result, anticipated ending expenses for 2021 was increased by \$3,000, and in Designated/Future Expenses 2022, the line \$3,500 Year 1 of 2 Comprehensive Plan was removed. The extra \$500 then was added to the 2022 park budget.

No changes were made to the amount of revenues for the proposed budget for the General Fund and levy. No changes were made to the amount of expenses and revenues for the proposed budget for the Sewer Utility.

As of 4:24 p.m., no one appeared before the Village Board. President Nicks called out three times for public comment on the proposed 2022 budget and levy for the Village of Boaz.

Receiving no response, Trustee Gies made a motion to add an action item to the November 9, 2021 regular meeting agenda of the Boaz Village Board to adopt the proposed budgets and levy; seconded by Trustee Adrian. Motion carried.

Trustee Adrian made motion to adjourn the public hearing at 4:27 p.m.; seconded by Trustee Gies. Motion carried.
