

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING USE OF STREETS AND ALLEYS
IN CONNECTION WITH SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT

WHEREAS, this Village Board is in the process of planning and providing for the installation and construction of a sewerage collection, treatment and disposal system;

WHEREAS, the collection system provided includes as a part of its collection system a grinder pump effluent pressure discharge system;

WHEREAS, the plans for such system as approved by this Board uses the streets and alleys of the Village as a site for the various collection and transmission lines;

WHEREAS, the site for some of the pump stations and grinder stations are located within the boundaries of various alleys within the Village;

WHEREAS, the use of the streets and alleys of the Village for such purposes is a public purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BOAZ, RICHLAND COUNTY, WISCONSIN, AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

By this resolution the Village Board of the Village of Boaz hereby grants a perpetual easement to its sewerage utility to use the right-of-ways of the streets and alleys of said Village and any or either of them for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining sewer mains, manholes, pump stations, grinder stations, and other appurtenances of said sewerage system.
