Public Hearing on the Proposed 2023 Budget and Levy for the Village of Boaz, Richland County  
and on the Proposed Increase in Monthly Sewer Utility Fees for Boaz Sewer Utility

President Nicks called the public hearing to order at 4:00 p.m.

Two changes were made to the expenses for the General Fund since the October regular meeting of the Boaz Village Board. Clerk/Treasurer Hauri received a Memorandum Agreement for ambulance services on 10-14-22. Since there were an average of 10 calls per year over the last four years, the per-year charge to the Village of Boaz for calendar years 2023, 2024, and 2025 will be \$1,700, not the \$700 that had been budgeted. "Park" was changed from \$17,300 to \$16,300 to account for the \$1,000 increase for "Ambulance/EMS."

No changes were made to the amount of revenues for the proposed budget for the General Fund and levy. No changes were made to the amount of expenses and revenues for the proposed budget for the Sewer Utility. No changes were made to the proposed increase of sewer utility fees.

As of 4:10 p.m., no one appeared before the Village Board. President Nicks called out three times for public comment on the proposed 2023 budget and levy for the Village of Boaz.

Receiving no response, Trustee Gies made a motion to add an action item to the November 15, 2022 regular meeting agenda of the Boaz Village Board to adopt the proposed 2023 budgets, levy, and sewer rate increase; seconded by Trustee Adrian. Motion carried.

Trustee Adrian made a motion to adjourn the public hearing at 4:12 p.m.; seconded by Trustee Gies. Motion carried.
