**OFFICIAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND CONSIDERATION
OF ADOPTION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 2023-2033 FOR

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Village of Boaz, Richland County, Wisconsin, will hold a public hearing at 5:30 p.m. on February 23, 2023 at the Boaz Community Building for the purpose of hearing recommendations on the proposed Village of Boaz Comprehensive Plan 2023-2033.

The proposed Comprehensive Plan is an update to the Village of Boaz Comprehensive Plan adopted September 6, 2005 and amended August 18, 2020. Updates include changes to all required sections of the plan. A series of public meetings informed the creation of the Comprehensive Plan 2023-2033.

The DRAFT Comprehensive Plan is posted online at www.villageofboaz.com/comprehensive-plans. The proposed Comprehensive Plan also is on file and available for public inspection at the Village Clerk's office.

The Boaz Plan Commission invites the public to speak or submit written comments on the proposed Comprehensive Plan at the public hearing. Written comments also may be submitted prior to the public hearing. Written comments will be given the same weight as oral testimony and will be part of the public record.

The Boaz Plan Commission will review the comments received following the public hearing and may take action to recommend the adoption of the plan by the Boaz Village Board, with or without changes to the draft. The Boaz Village Board may take action to adopt the Comprehensive Plan at a meeting scheduled immediately following the meeting of the Boaz Plan Commission.
