SUMMARY:

Under direction from the Line Foreman and/or Lead Lineman or his representative performs the Lineman A duties including construction and maintenance of overhead and underground electrical distribution and transmission systems; demonstrates a full understanding of all applicable policies, procedures and work methods associated with assigned duties; performs other related duties as required.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: (include but not limited to the following)

- Constructs, installs, and maintains overhead and underground distribution lines and systems. Examples of duties includes digging holes and trenches, setting poles, climbing poles, stringing wire, placing equipment, testing systems, installing customer meters.
- Performs after-hours duties, as required. Responds to callouts in a timely manner. Works scheduled and unscheduled overtime, as needed or as required.
- Customer service: Interacts with public during the normal course of business, in the utility office and in the field. Behaves in a courteous, professional manner.
- Performs other duties as assigned. The utility may revise the duties and responsibilities of this position as needed.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Typical Electric Utility Lineman working conditions to construct and maintain utility system including dark, wet, hot, and cold. The incumbent may use chemicals which may expose the employee to fumes, dust and air contaminants.

▲ Education and /or Experience:

Any combination of education and experience that has provided the knowledge, skill, and abilities necessary for an Electric Utility Lineman A. A minimum requirement of Technical Diploma Electrical Power Distribution or equivalent from an accredited trade school.

License/Certificate:

Possession of, or the ability to obtain a valid Wisconsin driver's license with Commercial Driver License endorsement (CDL) and Journeyman Lineman Certification
