ORDINANCE No. 622

An Ordinance of the Municipal Code of the City of Kiel Amending Chapter 17 (Zoning)

The Common Council for the City of Kiel do ordain as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: Chapter 17.33 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 17.33 (3) POLITICAL AND CAMPAIGN-TEMPORARY SIGNS. Temporary political and campaign sign means a sign that is not solidly affixed to the ground or to a building and displayed not more than 60-days within a six-month period for an event or occasion. on behalf of candidates for public office or measures on election ballots Temporary signs are allowed subject to the following regulations:
- (a) Temporary Said signs may be erected not earlier than 30 days prior to the commencement of the event or occasion election campaign, as defined in Wis. Stat. § 12.04(1)(a), and shall be removed within 5 days following the event or occasion applicable election. Moving a sign on the property does not reset the limitations of the time restrictions.
- (b) Temporary Signs shall not exceed 11 square feet in all zoning districts.
- (c) No temporary sign shall be located within 15 feet of a public right-of-way at a street intersection, nor within the public right-of-way or vision clearance.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication in accordance with the law.
