- 1) Mayor Bob Hennings called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm
- 2) Pledge of Allegiance
- 3) Roll Call was taken with Alderpersons Fromm, Guell, Brocker, Krueger, and Achter were present. Also present were City Staff CA Pafford and GMU August, as well as citizens Tom Brickbauer, Tom DeBruin, and Nancy Zimmerman
- 4) Alder Brocker moved, Alder Guell seconded to approve the minutes of March 10, 2026, City Council Meeting. The motion passed unanimously
- 5) Public Comment – Citizen Tom DeBruin spoke on a claim that was made for the dam. He asked GMU August to give the council background on the claim, in which he explained the instances that led to it. Alder Guell asked for clarification on the structure in question and its type. It was described as a lean-to covered on three sides. Mr. DeBruin explained the claim and what it included.
- 6) Alder Guell moved, Alder Brocker seconded to approve the design concept of field stone with coloring on each side for the First Street Bridge Design Options. The motion passed unanimously
- 7) Alder Fromm moved, Alder Krueger seconded to approve and certify the list. of Election Workers for the 2026–2027 Election Cycle. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 6 – Kiel Utilities Water Treatment Garage

Discussion and possible action

Background:

The City identified a need for a new storage garage at the Kiel Utilities Water Treatment Plant to support operational and maintenance activities. The proposed garage will provide protected storage space for equipment and materials associated with water treatment operations.

The City solicited competitive bids for the construction of the new storage garage. The bid specifications included an optional component for installing gutters on the east side of the building.

Fiscal Impact / Funding Source:

The project cost of \$148,700 will be funded from available excess funds from the original Water Treatment Plant capital project, generated by interest earned during the project period. These funds are within the Water Utility capital project accounts and are available for this purpose. Approval of this item will not require the use of General Fund revenues or additional borrowing.

Discussion:

Bids were received and reviewed by staff for completeness and compliance with project specifications. **Lake Ridge Construction, LLC** submitted the lowest responsible bid in the amount of **\$148,700**, which includes the optional east-side gutters. Staff has reviewed the bid and finds it to be responsive and consistent with the project scope.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends awarding the bid for construction of the **new Kiel Utilities Water Treatment Plant storage garage** to **Lake Ridge Construction, LLC** in the amount of **\$148,700**, including the optional gutters, as presented.

Item 7 – Kiel High School Fireworks Permit

Discussion and possible action

Background:

A fireworks permit request has been submitted on behalf of Kiel High School for a fireworks display associated with the high school graduation ceremony scheduled for June 7, with a

rain date of June 8. Approval by the Common Council is required under Wisconsin State Statutes and City ordinance.

Discussion:

The fireworks permit application has been reviewed by City staff and has been found to meet all applicable state and local regulations. Required documentation, including proof of insurance, has been submitted and satisfies City requirements. The fireworks display will be conducted by a properly licensed operator, and coordination with local emergency services will occur as necessary prior to the event.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends Council approval of the fireworks permit for Kiel High School's graduation event on June 7, with a rain date of June 8, as the application meets all regulatory and insurance requirements.

Item 8 – Six-Month Class “B” Alcohol Beverage License – Kiel Baseball Club

Discussion and possible action

Background:

The Kiel Baseball Club has submitted an application for issuance of a six-month Class “B” Alcohol Beverage License. This type of license is typically issued for seasonal operations where alcohol beverages are sold and consumed on the licensed premises during a defined period.

Discussion:

The application has been reviewed by City staff and has been found to meet the requirements of Wisconsin State Statutes and City ordinances governing alcohol beverage licensing. Required application materials, including the license application and associated documentation, have been submitted and reviewed. The license would allow alcohol sales in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Class “B” license for the approved six-month period.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends Council approval of the six-month Class “B” Alcohol Beverage License for the Kiel Baseball Club, subject to compliance with all applicable state laws, City ordinances, and standard licensing conditions.

Item 9 – Temporary Alcohol Beverage License – Kiel River Walk District (Celebrate Kiel)

Discussion and possible action

Background:

A request has been submitted by the Kiel River Walk District for a Temporary Alcohol Beverage License in connection with Celebrate Kiel, an event to be held at Hingiss Park. Temporary alcohol beverage licenses are issued pursuant to Wisconsin State Statutes and City ordinance for approved special events where alcohol beverages are sold and consumed for a limited duration.

Discussion:

The application has been reviewed by City staff and has been found to comply with all applicable state statutes and City ordinances governing temporary alcohol beverage licensing. All required documentation has been submitted. The proposed location at Hingiss Park and the scope of alcohol service are consistent with prior special events. Alcohol beverage sales will be conducted in accordance with the terms of the temporary license and standard City requirements.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends Council approval of the Temporary Alcohol Beverage License for the Kiel River Walk District for the Celebrate Kiel event to be held at Hingiss Park, subject to compliance with all applicable state laws, City ordinances, and standard licensing conditions.

Base bids ranged from \$147,500.00 -\$247,150.00. The apparent low bidder was Lake Ridge Construction, LLC, Kiel WI. A bid tabulation is enclosed.

I have reviewed the documents submitted with the bid and everything appears to be in order. Therefore, I am recommending the City award the contract to Lake Ridge Construction LLC for the bid amount of \$148,700.00 which includes the optional gutters on the east side.

General

Where "Owner" or "City" is mentioned herein, it means the City of Kiel. Where "Contractor" is mentioned it means the lowest responsible bidder to whom the work described herein is awarded by the Owner.

Location

The work site is located within the City of Kiel at the Kiel Wastewater Treatment Plant, 100 Rockville Rd, Kiel, WI 53042.

Scope of Work

The City of Kiel is looking to construct a building located at their Wastewater Treatment Plant. The construction is to include a 30' x 80' 13' 8" building on a concrete grade beam and include electrical service.

The contractor shall maintain safe access for City personnel and protect all adjacent utilities, pavements, and operational facilities throughout construction.

The designated construction location is shown in the attached red-box area.

Specifications

Mobilization. All costs for mobilization of equipment and materials to the work site shall be included in the respective bid item.

Traffic Control and Access. Contractor shall provide and maintain advanced construction signage, immediate work zone signage and additional devices as required to mark hazard within the project limits. All signage shall be retroreflective and located in accordance with MUTCD standards. All costs shall be inclusive to the work being completed.

Erosion Control. Erosion control shall be provided by the Owner and shall be maintained by the Contractor until work is completed.

Unclassified Excavation. All excavation and base placement is assumed to be completed by the Owner. The City will prepare the building site by removing existing asphalt, installing required base aggregate to within two inches of final grade by May 1, 2026. The Contractor shall provide final finish grading and preparation for all work. Contractor shall coordinate any additional base aggregate required with the Owner.

Restoration. All restoration of the site shall be completed by the Owner, including turf restoration and asphalt restoration.

Building. The contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to construct a 30' x 80' x 13'-8" pre-engineered wood-frame building as described below. All work shall meet the City of Kiel specification and the latest edition of the State of Wisconsin Standard Specifications. The building shall be

erected in full compliance with the building manufacturer's written installation instructions, including all required fasteners, bracing, and anchors.

Walls:

- 2 x 6 treated bottom plates anchored to concrete slab w/ 1/2" x 6" LTD 4' O/C
- 2 x 6 studs on 16" centers
- Double studs at truss locations
- 2 x 6 double top plates
- 2 x 10 box headers over walk doors and windows
- Double 14" LVL headers above overhead doors
- 2 x 4 girts on sidewall of building on 32" centers
- Walls to be covered with Tyvek, colored steel, steel fastened with colored fasteners
- Interior walls to be lined with white liner steel above 8' of 1/2" BCX sanded plywood

Roof:

- 30' trusses on 4' centers
- 2 x 4 purlins spaced on 24" centers
- 18" overhang on east side
- No overhang on the remaining 3 sides
- Roof covered with colored steel and colored fasteners
- Ceiling lined with white liner steel

Accessories:

- 5 – 4' x 3' windows, no grids
- 6 – 10' x 12' steel insulated (3216) overhead doors with openers (3 windows)
- 6 – 12' commercial garage door openers (1 remote per door)
- 2 – 92 series insulated exterior walk doors, no window

Insulation:

- Blown insulation + 1" spray foam
- R-50 ceiling
- R-28 exterior walls

Concrete Slab/Foundation.

Contractor to fully coordinate with building manufacturer.

The contractor shall prepare any required coordination drawings to confirm slab dimensions, anchor locations, overhead door clearances, and all other building interface requirements before concrete work begins.

The contractor shall be responsible for all final grading adjustments necessary to complete the building construction and shall also provide and install the concrete foundation, fully coordinating all dimensions, load requirements, and anchor locations with the building manufacturer.

Concrete slab is assumed to 30' x 80' grade beam. 16"x24" grade beam on all edges with #4 bars double mat at 1' on center. Slab shall have uniform thickness of 5" with #3 rebar @ 2' on center. All rebar shall have a minimum of 2" clear from all exposed edges. Concrete shall have a minimum of 4,000 PSI, machine finished, sealed and sawcut joints.

Electrical.

The contractor shall verify all utility service locations and coordinate all necessary plumbing and electrical connections with the appropriate utility providers and the Owner.

Contractor shall install:

- 100-amp single phase 120/240 volt 3R Square D electrical panel and grounding
- 10 LED canopy light fixtures 10,000 Lumen 5000k controlled by 2 motion sensors
- 2 exit lights with remove egress heads and exterior egress heads at door stops
- Wiring to 2-10,000 lumen wall packs on west side of building and 2-3,000 lumen wall packs over service doors
- Power to 6 overhead door operators including low voltage wiring to safety eyes and door push buttons located adjacent to each door they control.
- 10 GFCI receptacles spaced around the interior perimeter of the building

Contractor shall provide wiring for 100 amp 120/240 volt 4 wire feed from existing building to feed new building.

All wiring to be installed in EMT conduit with compression fittings.

Time of Completion. The project will be ready to be constructed by May 1, 2026. All work shall be completed by October 30, 2026.

Staking

All layout and staking shall be completed by the Contractor and coordinated with the Owner on placement of the concrete slab and building. Contractor shall verify building corners with the Owner prior to concrete placement.

Permits

Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining all permitting for construction. All costs shall be inclusive to the respective work being completed.

Notification

Contractor shall notify the Owner a minimum of 14 days prior to starting work.

Quantities, Payment and Changes

All quantities shown on the bid schedule are estimated. Payment for unit price items shall be based on actual quantities installed. Contractor to field verify all installed quantities. There will be no adjustments to work items bid by the lump sum.

Contractor shall submit applications for payment to the Owner. Documentation and/or tickets of actual quantities shall be included with applications for payment. Owner will review and process complete applications for payment within 30 days of receipt. Contractor shall submit a final request for payment within 30 calendar days of completion and acceptance of work.

The contractor shall field-verify all dimensions, elevations, and site conditions prior to ordering materials or starting work to ensure compatibility with components of the project. Any changes to conditions shall be immediately coordinated with the Owner.

All change orders must be submitted in writing and approved by the City before any additional work is performed.

Insurance

Contractor shall attach a valid Certificate of insurance to his completed Bid Document to be considered for award.

Warranty

The contractor shall provide a minimum one-year warranty on all workmanship and materials, in addition to passing through all applicable manufacturer warranties.

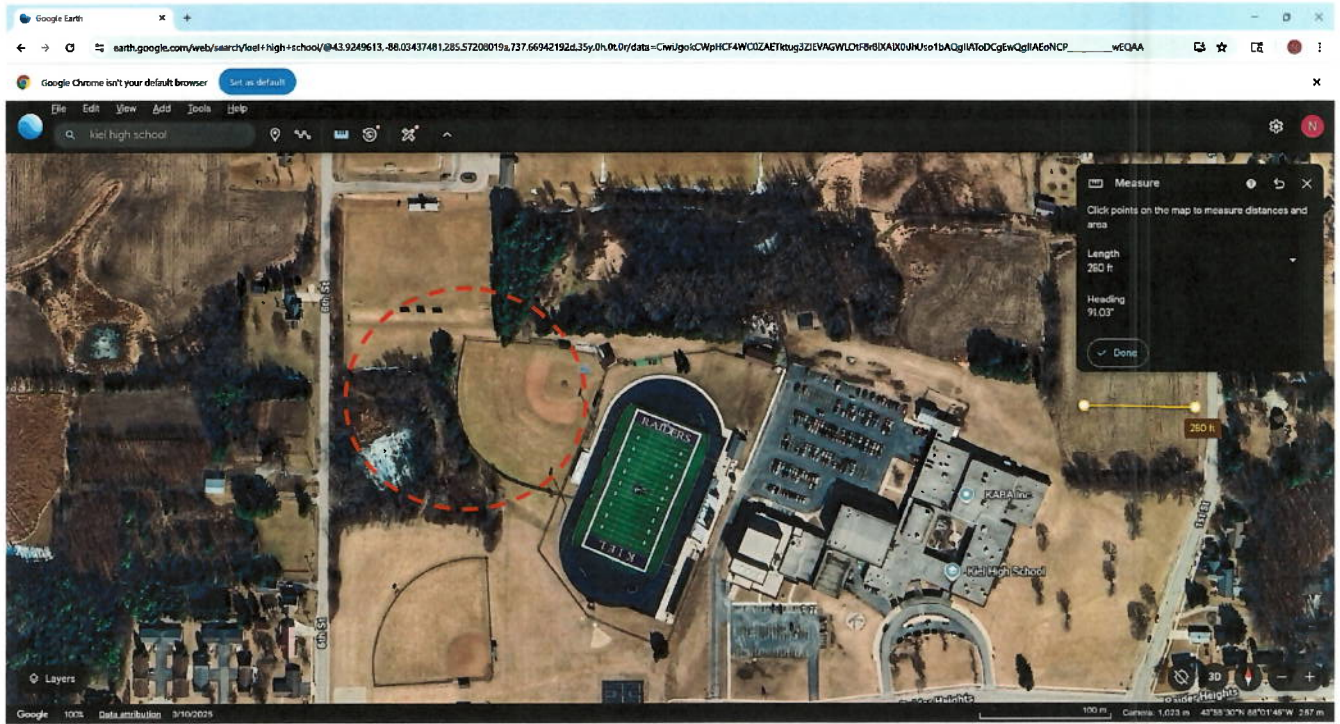


