- 9) Alder Guell moved, Alder Brocker seconded to approve the Temporary Alcohol Beverage License Kiel River Walk District (Celebrate Kiel) June 22 2026. Voting Aye were Alders Guell, Brocker, Krueger, and Achter. The motion carried 4-0.
- 10) Alder Krueger moved, Alder Brocker seconded to approve the gracious donations from Lori Krueger in Memory of Marian Schneider- \$25 (Kiel Fire Dept Ambulance), Kiel Community Chest- \$1,000 (Kiel Fire Dept Ambulance), Kiel Community Chest- \$1,000 (Kiel Police Department), Kiel Community Chest- \$1,000 (Kiel Public Library). The motion carried unanimously.
- 11) Alder Krueger moved, Alder Brocker seconded to approve receipts and disbursements. The motion carried unanimously.
