ABOUT THE PROJECT:

We are excited to announce our plans to build a new pedestrian bridge over the Sheboygan River. Our existing bridge is over 50 years old and in dire need of replacement.

OUT WITH THE OLD.....



Currently we are raising funds to design, engineer, remove and rebuild the iconic Kiel pedestrian bridge. The style of the bridge has been selected by the Kiel City Council. It will be a bow-style bridge that is wider and ADA compliant. The design will include a straight staircase. **Please consider donating to this exciting project!** Our intention is to have the new bridge installed by Fall, 2023.

PROJECT GOALS:

1. Construct a new, iconic, state-of-the-art, ADA Compliant, pedestrian bridge over the Sheboygan River to connect the Kiel Community Center, the Kiel Public Library and Hingiss Park to all of our historic downtown.
2. Beautify the area with updated landscaping and riverbank abutments.
3. Strengthen our downtown and attract tourism to the Kiel area.

Construction begins	Summer 2023
Completion	Late fall 2023
