To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, known as the "Non Profit Corporation Law," approved May 5, 1933, the undersigned, all of whom are natural persons of full age, residents of the Commonwealth, and all of whom are citizens of the United States, hereby associate themselves together for the purposes hereinafter specified and desire that they may be incorporated according to law, do certify:

1. The name of the proposed corporation is the LYRIC BAND OF HANOVER, PENNSYLVANIA.
2. The location and post office address of its initial office is Nos. 20-22 York Street, Hanover, Pennsylvania.

3. The said corporation is formed for the following purposes:

To be a means of outlet for those wishing to play band or musical instruments, and to be a medium for the purpose of bettering all who are connected with it, both individually and collectively; and further to promote a musically minded spirit in the community.

4. The said corporation is to exist perpetually.

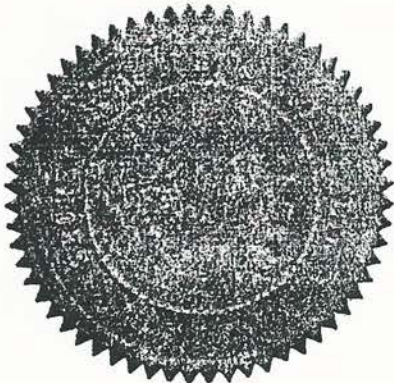
