### ***BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,***

In the Gospel today, Jesus predicted His suffering, death and resurrection for the third time. His earlier two predictions were not understood by the disciples, and their lack of understanding led Jesus to define and clarify the nature of Christian discipleship and its cost. The cup stands for the cup of bitter suffering of Jesus to atone for the sins of the entire humanity under the dominion of sin and death. The Baptism stands for the Baptism of Blood that He would endure during His passion and crucifixion. Jesus foresaw that James would be killed in 44 A.D., and John would suffer exile in Patmos Island as a victim of Emperor Domitian's persecution. Jesus knew the disciples would be servants and slaves with Him, the suffering servant of God. We pray for the graces to be willing and dedicated servants of Jesus and His Catholic Church.
