GUIDELINES

This contest is open to any Terrebonne Parish child, grades Pre-K through 12 and/or ages four (4) through seventeen (17). There will be 8 winners chosen (based on entries). All entries must contain artist's first and last name, age, and grade on the back of the artwork. A completed **Entry Form** must also be affixed to the back of each piece of artwork with glue or tape ONLY. Please do not fold artwork or attach anything with paperclips or staples.

The artist is to **redesign** the cover of her/his favorite childhood book. We encourage the artist to be creative and make it their own! The artwork must contain the title of the book and the author's name.

TFAE especially encourages the artist to explore the books offered through DOLLY PARTON'S IMAGINATION LIBRARY. You can find this list at <https://imaginationlibrary.com/usa/book-list/>. Eight (8) winners will be chosen. Artworks picked as winners will then be turned into lamp post banners that will be displayed on the light post lining the Courthouse Square in historical downtown Houma. Each banner will include the artist's name and age.

All entries must be received by Katie Portier or Ricky Murphy no later than Friday, April 24, 2020 at 4:30 p.m.--see Page 1 for delivery addresses. The artist may enter multiple pieces but each entry must have its own entry form attached. TFAE is not responsible for entries that are late, damaged, or lost. All winners artwork will be converted into banners and displayed in historical downtown Houma.


All entries will be displayed in an art exhibit at the Houma Main Library.

ARTWORK:

Artwork/Entries must be the child's original work! Artwork may not exceed 11 x 17 inches in size and paper must be **VERTICAL in orientation** (see examples on right.)

Please keep in mind that the pieces will have to be scanned in order to be transferred to a banner. **Artwork with filled in backgrounds (no white spaces) look best.**

Acceptable art media: paint, pencil, markers, ink, crayon, chalk or pastel (fixed), and photography.
