From the Kitchen: Spring Salad

1 pint Mayonnaise 1 cup sugar
1 cup white vinegar 1 can Eagle brand milk
3 grated carrots 1 small onion
3 sticks of celery 1 can spam diced
1/2 cup chopped green pepper

Cook 1 pd shell macaroni. Mix all ingredients together the night before to marinate at least 10 hours.
