Soup Kitchen Board is expanding its feeding program to include a sack breakfast on Saturdays. These meals will be available at the old Save A Lot building where the Tuesday evening meals are distributed. FPC will begin with breakfast bags filled with sausage and biscuits, hash brown square and orange juice for 50 people. We could use other church members to help wrap the food, pack the bags, help with kitchen cleanup and distribute the food at the Save A Lot parking lot. Cooking will begin around 7:30 in our church kitchen with bags ready for distribution at 9:00. 




