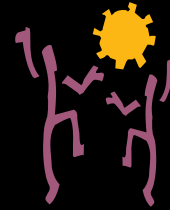

Twenty-four students in the Lake Elsinore Unified School District (LEUSD) were the beneficiaries of "Gearing Up For STEM" workshops and assembling their very own robot kits.
