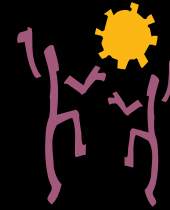

VBS was held Monday - Friday, 9:00 am to noon. Campers participated in evening Chapel Services edifying their spirit through the ministry of worship and God's Word.

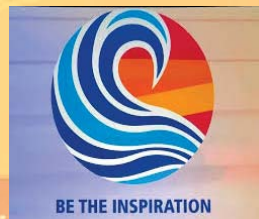
During free time campers got to swim in the river, ride bikes, hike and share stories around the camp fire.
