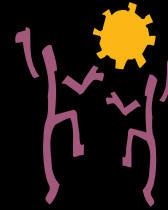

"Gearing Up for STEM" Mentor Protégé Camp

Community Outreach Ministry held a STEM Mentor Protégé day camp doing back to back classes setting up at 11:00 am and ending at 2:00 pm. Students participating were three seventh grade boys, five eighth grade students including two girls and three boys and two ninth grade boys. The mentoring team was made up of COM's co-founder Bob Davies engineer, Jacori Neal, tenth grade student mentor at Temescal Canyon High School in Lake Elsinore. Jacori has self-taught himself to build and program Meccano Robots. The mentoring team's goal is to inspire youth to seek higher education in STEM to be challenged and qualified in technology skills. This is important in order to acquire better vocational jobs earning higher pay and to have a prosperous and blessed future.

Our Future Demands STEM

More than 1.2 million job openings in STEM-related occupations in 2018 per the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics: November 2009.

- Only 16% of Bachelor's Degrees in 2020 will specialize in STEM per the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics 2010.
- Students need to be encouraged in the positive aspects of STEM in early education in order to be prepared in lucrative job fields.
