- Lawn watering Ordinance was approved in 2013 establishing lawn watering restrictions. The Superintendent of Public Works has the authority to implement emergency periods. Odd day/odd house number, even day/even house number. Only exception that will be granted is new sod. 1st time will be a warning, the second violation is \$25 per day, and a \$50 per day fine for the violation.
- The 2013 Consumer Confidence Water report was mailed w/ last month's sewer/water/garbage bill.
- ♦ STORM SIREN: We will continue to test alert the 1st Wednesday of each month. Pipestone Law Enforcement sounds the siren. DO NOT CALL, Take Shelter! If the siren sounds at other times go inside & tune to the local media!
- Building permits are needed: Doing some remodeling, adding a deck, or MOVING in a utility shed, this also includes installation of a fence
- Water Leaks: ALWAYS be on the lookout for water leaks! DO NOT FLUSH BABY WIPES, TAMPONS, Q-TIPS, grease, these items do not disintegrate! Check toilets & water meters for leaks.
- ♦ City utility payments are due on the 20th of each month! \$10 LATE FEE! Turn Water back on \$30, bad check \$30 + \$5 bank fee! Plan accordingly! New Residents \$100 deposit required.
- ♦ Pet License are PAST DUE! \$5 late fee will be added! There are many animals in town that are not registered at the city office.
- ♦ DO NOT let your animal leave their manure on other residents properties, if you take them for a walk cleanup after it. Remember that there is a leash law in Jasper! Complaints go to the Pipestone Law Enforcement @ 825-6700 or anonymous calls taken at 825-6792.

- ⇒ City bills can be paid in person at the city office, drop box at the city office or People's Bank.
- ⇒ Sump Pumps: It's ILLEGAL to pump into the sewer. Put in your yard (not the neighbors) or on the street!
- ⇒ Yard waste pickup w/ tag & in bag or container need to be on the curbside on Monday mornings at 8 a.m. sharp, weight limits apply.
- ⇒ Public Access Channel 3: News, events & announcements. (Non-profit org. or event). Fax 825-5353.
- ⇒ Bookmobile at St. Joseph Catholic Church 2nd & 4th Wednesday of the month from 11 am—12 pm.



HOUSE NUMBERING REQUIRED CITY ORDINANCE SECTION 6.17: In case of an emergency it is easier for the Fire Trucks & Ambulance to find your home with the number displayed by the front door, 3" or larger numbers of a contrasting color. Anyone violating the ordinance could face a misdemeanor or petty misdemeanor fine. Before any emergency happens post!
