RIVERBOAT DAYS PARADE INSURANCE AND INDEMNIFICATION

Such insurance shall include general liability and/or auto liability insurance policy insuring against death, injury or damage occasioned by negligence arising from or incidental to the operation to parade entry.

Parade entry agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Yankton Riverboat Days, Inc. from any and all damages to persons or property or from any other claims, liabilities, costs or expenses (including attorney's fees), resulting from the acts or omissions, including default or negligence of Yankton Riverboat Days, Inc. or its directors, officers, employees, principals, agents, successors or assigns arising from or as a result of the performance of this contract.
