



Ribs, Rods & Rock n' Roll Backyard BBQ

Date: September 7, 2024

Location: Vermillion, SD

Team Rules

Entry Fee: There is a \$100 deposit fee, for each team. When you turn in your ribs for judging, you will receive your \$100 back.

Registration: Limited to the first 10 teams!

Ribs : Each team will be provided 8-10 racks of ribs for the competition upon registration starting at 6am on Saturday, September 7th.

Time: You will turn in 100 ribs to a Ribs, Rods & Rock n' Roll committee member at 4PM. Backyard BBQ people's choice judging will begin at 5PM on the 7th and will run until 7PM.

Alcohol: Malt beverages are allowed within the boundaries of the Ribs, Rods & Rock n' Roll event. Alcohol cannot be sold at Backyard BBQ booths.

Weather: The event will take place regardless of weather. Backyard BBQ Ribfest Teams may set up at their discretion. Cancellation of the event is up to the judgment of the Ribs, Rods & Rock n' Roll Committee. No Refunds will be given due to inclement weather.

Site Preparation: Site preparation will begin at 6am on Saturday. After 8am on Saturday vehicles will not be allowed in the Backyard BBQ Ribfest area and items will need to be carried to assigned booth.

Trash: Each team will be provided 1- 50 gallon garbage can and liners at your booth (MUST USE LINERS). We will have a dumpster available to all teams to dispose of their garbage.

Electricity: Because of restricted access to power, no power will be provided to Backyard BBQ participants. Please bring your own portable, quiet generators if power is needed.

Gas & Coals: All hot coals must be placed in the steel barrels near each booth. Each team must provide a UL listed connection for all propane tanks. Propane cooking tanks must be stored in grids at least 10 feet from the cooking area.

Clean-up: All contestants are responsible for keeping their space clean and sanitary and must have their booths deconstructed and removed from Competition area by 8am Sunday.

Extra Ribs: Any extra ribs can be distributed AFTER the people's choice has finished. No ribs can be sold at Backyard BBQ booths.

People's Choice and Rib sampling: Patrons may participate in the people choice judging of the Backyard BBQ Ribfest by purchasing a plate for \$20 at the Ribs, Rods & Rock n' Roll booth. (Next to the Beer Garden)

GENERAL RULES:

1. Proper storage of meat is required. It must be maintained below 40 degrees or above 140 degrees.
2. Your booth should have a free-flowing spigot container of water with an on/off valve and a catch container, hand soap and disposable towels for proper hand washing. A second container with bleach water should be kept for wiping counters, etc.
3. Booths are to be no more than 20x20 feet and must be positioned so that they sit up against the curb of the street. If you require more space for your setup, reach out to us. You will not be allowed to use the sidewalk behind your booth for storage.
4. Placement of your booth will be determined by the Ribs, Rods & Rock n' Roll Committee.
5. Each team will be responsible for any equipment they might need such as tables, tent, cover, etc.
6. Teams must provide their own safety inspected (5 lbs minimum) multi-purpose ABC dry chemical fire extinguisher.
