

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that Tunkhannock Township Board of Supervisors will hold a public meeting/hearing to be held on May 10, 2017, at 7:00 p.m., at Tunkhannock Township Municipal Building, Long Pond Road, Long Pond, PA 18334, to consider a request to adopt a Resolution approving the intermunicipal transfer of a Restaurant Liquor License to Tunkhannock Township, Monroe County, as the “receiving municipality” for use by Wildwood 115, Inc. t/a LaRoma Pizza at its existing restaurant located at 3827 Route 115, Blakeslee, PA (hereinafter the “Premises”).

The Intermunicipal Liquor License Transfer to Wildwood 115, Inc. t/a LaRoma Pizza for Restaurant Liquor License R-21327 to be located at 3827 Route 115, Blakeslee, PA 18610 and having a Tax Code No. of 20/8F/1/24. The subject premises is owned by Silvio Vitello.

The PA Liquor Code provides that, prior to adoption of a resolution by the receiving municipality, at least one hearing must be held by the governing body of the municipality, for the purpose of permitting individuals residing within the municipality to make comments and recommendations regarding the applicant’s intent to transfer a Liquor License into the receiving municipality.

The public is invited to present comments at said public meeting/hearing concerning the Board of Supervisors’ decision on the transfer of Intermunicipal Restaurant Liquor License to said premises.
