The successful bidder will be required to provide a Performance and Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price within 20 days of the award of the contract. All bids will be opened on Wednesday, April 01, 2020 at approximately 9:00 A.m.

The tentative award date and time is Wednesday, April 08, 2020 at approximately 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the agenda allows.
