FPU will allow the installation of temporary service for the sole purpose of constructing a permanent service. Connection to the temporary service will cost \$30.00 and is valid for an initial period of nine (9) months. The initial period will begin when there is a current "passed" inspection from the Deputy State Electrical Inspector for the area, the service is constructed, and the service is energized to the bottom lugs of the meter base. One (1), nine (9) month extension is available after payment of an additional \$30.00 fee and receipt by FPU of an approved state electrical inspection. In the event extenuating circumstances are such that an additional nine (9) months is required, it may be issued by FPU **only** after additional fees are paid, approved electrical inspection is received, a representative of FPU has performed a site visit, and FPU has approved the extension.

The undersigned understands that this service equipment must be approved by the Deputy State Electrical Inspector and must bear his seal of approval. It is also understood that Fayetteville Public Utilities may refuse to connect service to any installation that has been altered or in any way altered after state approval was issued.

If at any time during the construction anyone takes up residence in the house or building utilizing this Temporary Service, electric service will be immediately terminated for safety purposes.

This construction service will be to a location approved by a Fayetteville Public Utilities staker/designer.

The undersigned hereby certifies that he agrees to the above requirements and accepts full and complete responsibility for operation for this service in accord with standards approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Act and the National Electric Code.
