

NOTICE REGARDING SENIOR CITIZEN TAX EXEMPTIONS

Property owners 65 years of age or older may be eligible for senior citizen tax exemptions on their primary residence.

Senior citizens have until **March 1st** to apply for such exemptions.

(this is not the same as the star exemption that applies to your school taxes)

The low-income Senior Citizen Exemption has income limits to qualify.

The income levels are as follows:

Town and County: \$26,400 or less

Bloomfield Central School: \$26,900 or less

Honeoye Falls/Lima Central School: \$32,400 or less

Disregard this notice if you have already applied for this exemption or are under 65 years of age.

The STAR exemption is still in effect. If you are in the basic star program and are getting an exemption on your school tax bill and will be turning 65, you can apply for the Enhanced Star Program with the Assessor by **March 1st** or move to the check program if you wish.
