Supervisor Campbell opened the meeting at 7:00 pm.

**RESOLUTION #41**

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer's Report

Supervisor Campbell asked for a resolution to approve the Code Enforcement Officer's report which was held over from the March 10<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Councilman Harman made the resolution to approve the Code Enforcement Officer's Report, seconded by Councilman Carey.

Comprehensive Plan Update

Supervisor Campbell explained what the Comprehensive Plan is and that updates are done to keep it current. He has people showing interest in being on the committee, and is hoping to form the committee this year so the update can be completed next year.

Town Facility Use

The Board discussed use of the pavilion and the Town Hall meeting room during the pandemic and the changing State and CDC guidelines that must be followed. Supervisor Campbell will contact Attorney Hou to get his recommendation on the language in the rental agreement. Councilman Harman will work with Supervisor Campbell to develop plans for use of the Town Hall.

Supervisor Campbell asked if there were any questions for the Board.

Sue Boardman, Zoning Board of Appeals Chair, advised the Board of concerns her Board has regarding the handling of applications and procedures not being followed. Councilman DeSanctis asked if this was an isolated incident. Mike Borgeest, Planning Board Member, advised the Board that the Planning Board has had problems also. Supervisor Campbell advised them he is working with the Clerk and Code Enforcement Officer to clarify the procedure.

County Road 35 and County Road 14 Intersection

Councilman Carey asked if there was an update to the discussion of the intersection at County Roads 14 and 35. Supervisor Campbell advised the Board that he spoke with the County and they will be doing an analysis of the intersection.

Councilman Carey advised the Board that he is working with the Honeoye Falls Fire Department on their plans for a new Fire Hall which may include expansion onto an adjacent property. He will keep the Board up to date as things proceed.
