Truck Purchase

Superintendent Ball advised the Board that in order to purchase the truck scheduled for next year he would need to send a letter of intent. He has estimates up to \$280,000.00. He has to send a letter of intent to get in line for a truck purchase due to current equipment shortages. The expected delivery date would be October of 2022, and the estimates are subject to change up to \$5,000.00. Councilman Harman made the resolution to approve the Highway Superintendent sending a letter of intent to purchase a 2023 10 wheel truck with dump box and plow equipment, from the 2022 budget, for a cost not to exceed \$280,000.00, with the right to cancel, without penalty, with 30 days notice, seconded by Councilman Carey.

Resolves that the Highway Superintendent is authorized to issue a letter of intent to purchase a 2023 truck, with a dump box and plow equipment, from the 2022 budget, at a cost not to exceed \$280,000.00, with the right to cancel without penalty, with 30 days notice.
