RESOLUTION #100

SET PUBLIC HEARING – LOCAL LAW NO. 2-2021 A LOCAL LAW PURSUANT TO N.Y. CANNABIS LAW § 131 TO OPT OUT OF LICENSING AND ESTABLISHING RETAIL CANNABIS DISPENSARIES AND/OR ON-SITE CANNABIS CONSUMPTION ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE TOWN OF WEST BLOOMFIELD.

WHEREAS, New York Cannabis Law § 131 allows local municipalities to adopt a local law, subject to permissive referendum, to opt-out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Town to adopt a local law, subject to permissive referendum, opting-out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within the Town; and

WHEREAS, a copy of such proposed local law is on file with the Town Clerk; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of West Bloomfield that a Public Hearing shall be had on the 27th day of October, 2021, at 7:00 PM, for the purpose of adopting Local Law No. 2-2021, a local law pursuant to N.Y. Cannabis Law § 131 to opt out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within the Town of West Bloomfield; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk advertise for said Public Hearing in a manner consistent with law; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk cause a copy of the proposed Local Law to be sent to the Ontario County Planning Board for its review pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 239-m.

Open House
