He asked for a resolution approving the filing of the law with the Secretary of State. Councilman Travis offered the following, seconded by Councilman DeSanctis:

RESOLUTION #128

EXPIRATION OF PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM REGARDING LOCAL LAW NO. 2 -2021 A LOCAL LAW PURSUANT TO N.Y. CANNABIS LAW § 131 TO OPT OUT OF LICENSING AND ESTABLISHING RETAIL CANNABIS DISPENSARIES AND/OR ON-SITE CANNABIS CONSUMPTION ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE TOWN OF WEST BLOOMFIELD.

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2021, the Town Board of the Town of West Bloomfield approved a Resolution to adopt Local Law No. 2-2021 to opt out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within the Town of West Bloomfield, subject to permissive referendum; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution was subject to permissive referendum; and

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk did duly post and publish a notice specifying that said Resolution was adopted subject to a permissive referendum; and

WHEREAS, the permissive referendum period has run and no petition in opposition to the Resolution has been filed; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to file and give due notice of the adoption of said Local Law to the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
