Please be brief when leaving a message.

### HEARING OF COMPLAINTS

**APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR GRIEVANCE, and MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO 4PM ON MAY 20<sup>TH</sup>. Hearings will be held by phone only.** Call the Assessor's office to schedule on Tuesdays 9am-2pm. Complaints may also be reviewed by mail as long as the documents are received by May 25<sup>h</sup>. Documents received May 26<sup>th</sup> are not timely filed and will not be heard. The Board of Assessment Review will meet on Wednesday May 25, 2022 at the West Bloomfield Town Hall, 9097 Daylight Dr, W. Bloomfield, between the hours of 4:00pm and 8pm to hear and examine all **scheduled phone** complaints in relation to assessment, on the application of any person believing himself to be aggrieved. **The BAR will call the complainant at their appointed time.**

**Attendance or a phone appointment with your complaint is not necessary to have it heard; only the timely filing of the completed complaint form.**
