

# Meet Max—HBO's new, enhanced streaming service

## What Is Max? The Streaming Home of HBO

In May, HBO Max became an enhanced streaming service called Max. The service features iconic programming, including all the HBO content you already love, like *Game of Thrones*. It is also home to crave-worthy genres, plus some of the most anticipated premieres. (So prepare to find some new favorites.) Basically, it's the one to watch.

Below, you'll learn the answers to more Max FAQs, like when Max will be available, how it differs from HBO Max, price details, and more. Think of this as your guidebook to everything Max.

## What's The Difference Between Max and HBO Max?

With Max, in addition to all your HBO Max content, you'll get a wealth of real-world shows in a wide range of genres, including reality, lifestyle, food, true crime, and more.

## How Do I Watch HBO on Max?

If you're currently subscribed to HBO Max, one of two things happened in May: The HBO Max app automatically updated to Max, or you were prompted to download the Max app. Either way, you are now able to start streaming a new show (or a permanent comfort watch) ASAP.

## Will I Still Have Access to HBO Content on Max?

Max is now the streaming home of HBO and includes everything that was on HBO Max. This means if you're in the middle of a series or have 30 minutes left in a hit movie, you won't have to miss a beat.

## How Do I Watch HBO?

Watching HBO shows on Max is as easy as opening an app. Just settle down on your couch and pull up Max. From there, you can search for specific HBO shows you've been meaning to watch or explore all the options available. Any time you spot something you want to save for later, you can add it to your watch list.

If you're used to watching HBO live on TV, that's still an option, too. Nothing is changing there. Visit HBO online at [HBO.com/schedule](https://www.hbo.com/schedule) to stay on top of what's on.

## Does Max Come With HBO?

HBO is a television network that'd delivered decades of entertainment; Max is a service where you can stream that content. Max includes all HBO content. And you're free to stream it all, from *Sex and the City* to *The Last Of Us*, whenever you want.

Whether you've got a favorite show or there's a great new show you'd like to watch, you don't have to remember when it's going to air or which channel it's on. Let your LightTube set-top box do it for you!

Using the Guide feature on your remote, find the program you're interested in, highlight it, and press OK. A pop-up menu will ask whether you'd like the set-top box to remind you when the program is on so that you can tune to it yourself or automatically tune to it without the reminder.

 Reminder set

The **REMINDER** feature allows you to ask the Interactive Guide to remind you when the selected program is about to air. After you press OK, follow the prompts to confirm that you'd like to set a reminder for that program. When you return to the guide, you will see an icon next to the title indicating a reminder has been set.

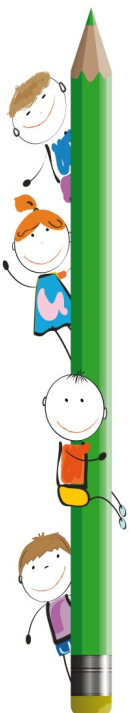
 Autotune set

When the program is about to air, a pop-up reminder will appear on screen. If you'd like to switch to your selected program, highlight its name and press OK. If you've changed your mind and want to keep watching your current program, press EXIT to close the reminder. If you do nothing for several minutes, the reminder will disappear and your channel will not change.

The **AUTOTUNE** feature allows you to ask the Interactive Guide to automatically tune to your selected channel when the selected program is about to air. Using the Guide, highlight the program you'd like to watch and press OK. Follow the prompts to set a reminder, then scroll down and toggle the "Autotune" box to "Yes." When you return to the guide, you will see an icon next to the program name indicating the autotune has been set.

When the program is about to air, a pop-up will appear on screen to warn you that the channel is about to change. If you've changed your mind, select CANCEL to keep watching your current program. If you do nothing for several minutes, the warning will disappear and the channel will change.

If you have a DVR, you can also tell the set-top box to **RECORD** the program whenever it's on so that you can watch it at a later time; but if you *don't* have a DVR, these other features can be very helpful!
