

## Department 6A Art – Open R1

**Please review "Exhibit Information - General Rules and Information." See "Main Menu - Calendar" for entry schedule.**

1. Art entries must not have been entered before.
2. Only original work is eligible; no copies of paintings, adult coloring nor drawings/paintings by number will be accepted.
3. All entries will be judged for awards. Each exhibitor will be represented in the show with one or more pieces of work. While every effort will be made to show all entries, the Fair reserves the right to make selections and arrange exhibits according to available space.
4. Only one entry allowed per class.
5. Overall dimensions shall not exceed 36" by 40". Item cannot weigh more than 10 pounds. Exhibits painted directly on wood shall not exceed ¼ inch in thickness.
6. All Open class entries shall be framed with hangers and wires in place.
7. Entrants must furnish their own hangers and wires and have them affixed to the art work at time of submission.
8. The Fair is not responsible for loss or damage.
9. The judges reserve the right to refuse articles that are not meritorious.
10. No nude pictures.
11. No computer graphics.
12. No painted or graphics on saws or saw blades.
13. Sculptures, wood carvings and other artistic media other than flat drawings and paintings are defined as Handicraft and should be submitted in Handicraft division and not Art division.
