

Department 7A Beef Cattle – Open R1 2019

Please review "Exhibit Information - General Rules and Information." See "Main Menu - Calendar" for entry schedule.

1. Entry forms must be completed for each animal and returned to the County Extension office prior to date posted in Calendar.
2. All beef cattle must be purebred (except as otherwise specified) and registration papers are required at time of entry.
3. No heifers or bulls in barn until the day of the show.
4. Where there is no competition in a class, second prize money will be given.
5. Animals will be classed by their registration papers. Each entry must have registration papers at time of entry and be in the name of the exhibitor except in crossbred and commercial divisions.
6. To be eligible to compete for premiums, all animals must be halter broken and well groomed. Bulls must have nose ring and lead. Cattle that are wild and not in creditable condition will be ruled out. All animals will be exhibited at owner's risk.
7. No more than two (2) entries may be made in one class by the same exhibitor.
8. Feed and care must be furnished by the exhibitors
9. Release of all Beef Cattle is 9:00 PM of the show day or when approved by Fair Authority
10. Health Regulations:
 - A. General: All cattle exhibited must appear in healthy condition. An official health certificate signed by an accredited veterinarian is not required.
 - B. Brucellosis:
 1. No test required on calves under 6 months of age
 2. No test required on officially calfhood vaccinated animals under 24 months
 3. No test required on Alabama cattle if they originate from a herd that is not under quarantine because of brucellosis
 - C. Tuberculosis: No TB test required
11. All Breeds
 - A. Separated into 6 classes based on age for each sex.
 - B. Class 01 will be for those born in the year of the fair.
 - C. Class 06 will be for 2 year old females born in the fall 2 years before the fair.

- B. Champion Bull and Female of Each Breed Rosette
- C. Reserve Champion Bull and Female of each Breed Rosette
