

## Department 1 Field and Garden Crops and Honey - Youth R 2020

1. Entries will be judged on originality and artistic merit.
2. Pumpkin entries must be produced by entrant. Entries will be completely painted or carved at time of submission. Paint must be dry. One entry per entrant per class.
3. All exhibits must remain in place in the Agricultural Exhibit Building until 8:00 AM Sunday, immediately following the last day of the Fair. All exhibits shall be picked up by 5:00 PM on that Sunday; exhibits not picked up by that time will be disposed of by the Fair staff.
4. Any produce which rots or decomposes will be removed from the display area and properly disposed. Awards and ribbons earned by the disposed produce will be retained for delivery to the exhibitor.
5. The "Young Child Special Submission" will only be used by the judges for items not covered in the "Open" Department 01 for customer service purposes.
